

ROMAN STRIPE

RAINBOW SCRAP CHALLENGE 2014 SCRAPHAPPY SAMPLER



This one is built off a four-patch unit. That means each subunit will measure 3.5 inches.

FABRIC

You will need three 1.5-inch strips of fabrics for this block; a light medium and dark are ideal. Each strip needs to be at least 14 inches long. If you don't have scraps that long, you can use two 7-inch strips or even four 3.5-inch strips.

CUTTING/SEWING



Sew the strips together and iron toward the dark. Press carefully to avoid distorting the strip set.



Sub-cut into squares that are 3.5 inches each. Use the seam lines to make sure your strip sets are straight. Arrange as shown.

FINISHING

Sew into a four patch. Your block should measure 6.5 inches.

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
