SWAMP ANGEL STAR


RAINBOW SCRAP CHALLENGE 2015 SAWTOOTH STAR SAMPLER

Swamp Angel Star is a pretty block with a very strange name. It is a minor variation of the Ohio Star block, so it should go together pretty quickly. The corners are replaced with HST units, which gives it a nice dimensional look. FABRIC

- 1.5-inch strips in two shades of green as well as background
- 2.5-inch strips in background and green.

CUTTING

Place the 2.5-inch strips right sides together and use the easy angle ruler to cut 4 HST pairs.



Finally, cut a 2.5-inch square of green fabric.







First, sew the 4 HST units together. Trim dog-ears and press toward the darker fabric

Next, start sewing the QST units, first into pairs and then into squares.

Your 8 finished subunits will be combined with the green square to make a nine patch. Arrange the units as shown





Sew them into a nine patch to make your finished star block.

FINISHING

Insert the block into your star points using <u>this tutorial</u> and you will be all set. Tada!

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
